## **PIAA Sports Physicals for Perkiomen Valley Students**

To participate in school sports, a valid PIAA sports physical is required, dated **after May 1, 2025.** While **Perkiomen Valley will not be hosting a Physical Day this year**, there are several options available to ensure your child is prepared for the season. The paperwork must be uploaded to <u>BigTeams/Student Central</u> by **JULY 18, 2025.** We have hundreds of these physicals to approve and process prior to the first day of practice so please turn them in on time.

## 1. Schedule an Appointment with Your Child's Primary Care Physician

- If your child has had a well visit within the past year, many doctors will complete the required PIAA form based on that visit.
- **Important**: It may take up to **2 weeks** to process, and some offices may charge a **form completion fee**.

## 2. Visit a Local Urgent Care or Walk-in Clinic

- These clinics often offer same-day appointments or walk-in service.
- Many accept insurance, but if you do not have coverage, here are some local options and their out-of-pocket fees for sports physicals:
